

CODE OF ETHICS TO CHECK MALPRACTICE AND PLAGIARISM

In order to promote academic integrity and prevention of plagiarism this institution maintains strict policy with regard to the research work carried out by the faculty members and students. These regulations are put in force in compliance with the vision and mission of the Institution. This institution mandates the regulations for assessment of academic and research work done leading to the partial fulfillment for the award of degrees at Masters level, by a student or a faculty member or a researcher or a staff, in the form of thesis, dissertation and publication of research papers, chapters in books, full-fledged books and any other similar work, reflects the extent to which elements of academic integrity and originality are observed. These regulations shall apply to the students, faculty members, researchers and staff of this Institution. This institution uses Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University prescribed Plagiarism software (Turnitin) to ensure that documents submitted by students, faculty members and staff are free of plagiarism. This Anti Plagiarism software is accessible to all engaged in research work including student, faculty members, researcher and staff. Every student submitting a thesis, dissertation, or any other such documents shall submit an undertaking indicating that the document has been prepared by him or her and that the document is his/her original work and free of any plagiarism. Every faculty member submitting a research paper, chapters in books, full-fledged books and any other similar documents shall submit an undertaking indicating that the document has been prepared by him or her and that the document is his/her original work and free of any plagiarism. The anti-plagiarism software facility is extended to the students and faculty members involved in research work leading to submission of Masters thesis and/or submission of research paper for publication in journal/conference. The students of M.Pharm are required to done their plagiarisn check from third party and submit the generated summary and detailed report alongwith the certificate in the college.

Similarity checks for exclusion from Plagiarism:

The similarity check for plagiarism excludes the following:

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- 1. All quoted work reproduced with all necessary permission and/or attribution.
- 2. All references, bibliography, table of content, preface and acknowledgements.
- 3. All generic terms, laws, standard symbols and standards equations.

The mechanism established and prescribed in the above code is to enhance the awareness about responsible conduct of research and academic activities, to promote academic integrity and to prevent plagiarism.
